
Welcome to **Digital Badging**

FAQs - Digital badging with Coastal Catalyst

How do I publish my badge for my earners to claim it?

After you've written your badge, email the Coastal Catalyst team on badging@futurecreators.org.uk to let us know it's ready. We'll check your badge, approve the Badging Standards, and publish it (via a platform called Open Badge Factory). We then create a badge application link and claim code for your earners and send this to you via email.

How long will it take to approve my badge?

Our admin team aim to approve in 48 hours. A lot of the quality assurance is done through Credwriter, meaning that we are just doing a final check and publishing.

Do I need to have earners emails to award a badge?

No! The badge application creates a link and a claim code that can be shared in any way you want. You could make a QR code to use during an event, send it in a follow-up email, share with teachers or even turn it into part of the feedback process. This allows earners to control their details and claim the badge for themselves.

Do earners need to share emails to claim a badge?

Earners will need to have an email address to receive a badge. By claiming their badge via the link, participants agree to share their email address with Future Creators and Talent Accelerator so that we can issue their badge. We won't use their email for anything else - unless they give us permission. We can use the information they give us to track the people who have claimed badges against the known participants in an event.

If having an email is a barrier for the young people you work with, please get in touch and we can work together to find a solution.

How many logins can our organisation have?

Each organisation gets one login, so we suggest you have a designated badge writer within your team. If multiple people will be writing badges, use an email that all badge writers can access.

No, once a badge is published the claim link and claim code can stay the same. If you do have any difficulties with claiming, we are here to support.

Credwriter doesn't currently have an 'import' function, but we can help you recreate any badges in Credwriter if you are still using them. Earners can store badges from all platforms in the My Skills Backpack, so you do not need to reissue badges to earners.
